USTA 18 and Over Mixed Doubles

Key Dates:

- Season: **January 10 - March 29**
- Initial roster deadline: **December 10** (6 players to field a minimum lineup)
- Final roster deadline: **February 10**
- Sectionals: 4/24-4/26 Orange County
Great Park, Irvine and Newport Beach Tennis Club
- USTA Nationals: Oct/ Nov TBD

Key Info:

- Format: 3 lines of mixed doubles
- Combined rating level teams: 6.0, 7.0, 8.0, 9.0, 10.0
 - Partner ratings are added together.
 - Pairs may have up to 1 point rating level difference (i.e. 3.0 + 4.0 for a 7.0 team)
- Max roster size: 16
- Days of play:
 - 6.0, 8.0, 10.0: 2:30PM Saturday
 - 7.0 and 9.0: Noon Saturday
 - 6.0 and 10.0 levels may be combined SD/ SDNC teams

USTA Adult 40 and Over League (Men's and Women's Leagues)

Key Dates:

- Season: **January 5 - March 29**
- Initial roster deadline: **December 10**
 - Adult 40+ 4 line team: 7 players minimum
 - Adult 40+ 3 line team (Women's WE, Men's 3.0): 5 players minimum
- Final roster deadline: **February 10**
- Sectionals:
 - Levels 3.5/ 4.5/ Capstone 5.0+ May 15-17
 - Levels 3.0/ 4.0 May 29- 31
 - San Diego: Barnes Tennis Center and Balboa Tennis Club
 - Sectionals format: 4 lines total - 1 singles and 3 doubles
- USTA Nationals: Oct/ Nov TBD
Format: 1 Singles/ 4 Doubles
- National Open Invitational (Capstone level only) Sept TBD; Format 3 Doubles

Key Info:

- Format: 1 line singles, 3 lines doubles (except women's weekend, see below)
- Maximum roster size: 18
- Rosters must have a minimum of 50% of players at NTRP level. Lower level players may 'play up'; higher level players cannot 'play down'.
- Days of play:
 - Men's Weekend:
 - North County: Sundays starting at 9 AM
 - San Diego: Sundays 9AM preferred but flexible times for select facilities
 - 3.0 level- 3 lines Saturday/ Sunday afternoons (TBD by team/ facility)
 - Women's weekday (starting at 9AM):
 - North County: Mon=4.0, Wed=4.5, Fri=3.0 and 3.5
 - San Diego (South): Mon= 3.0, Tues=4.5, Wed=4.0, Thurs=3.5
 - Women's weekend (3 lines)*:
 - Sunday afternoons (1 Singles/2 Doubles)
 - 3.5 and 4.0 Sundays at 2:30PM
 - 3.0 and 4.5 Sundays at Noon
 - Some facilities may need slightly later starting times due to Men's leagues.
 - Capstone 5.0+ (3 doubles lines)
 - Saturdays/ Sunday afternoons (Time TBD by team/ facility)
- Court options for 4 line leagues:
 - 2 courts start followed by 2 courts (2:2), or
 - 3 courts start followed by 1 court (3:1), or
 - 4 courts at one time

Key Dates:

- Registration opens: December 2
- Roster deadline: January 10 (2 players minimum) Can add players until Feb 10.
- Season: January 25 - March 29

Key Info:

- Age 18 and over
- Format: 1 line of doubles (2 -4 players per team)
- Women's Weekday days of play:
 - North County: Thursdays 9AM
 - San Diego: Fridays at 9AM (or 11AM court availability)
- Men's and Women's Weekend play times: Flexible weekend afternoon times

Winter/ Spring One Singles Flex League

Key Dates:

- Registration opens: December 2 and closes January 10
- Season: January 25 – April 26
 - Contacts/ Schedules will be published by 1/24 so you can start to arrange your matches.

Key Info:

Matches count toward 2026 year-end NTRP ratings.

To keep our levels true and competitive, players should play **at** their current NTRP level. This is the first season with the new 2025 year-end ratings so levels should be accurate. Top Fall finishers from One Singles League may be considered for 'play up'. If players do not meet these criteria, they will be transferred to their current NTRP level.

Please follow these steps to register in Tennislink.

- Your **USTA membership** needs to be current through April 2026.
- There is a \$32 league fee for the season.
- Log into your USTA account. Tennislink.USTA.com
- On the far-left tab, click on '**USTA League**'. (Not USTA Flex League')
- Underneath the header '**Start Playing**', click button to '**Register with team #**' and enter the number by level. Complete registration process through checkout
